#### 1.0 General Provisions

The provisions of this <u>Rregulation</u> shall not apply to the start-up and shutdown of equipment which operates continuously or in an extended steady state when emissions from such equipment during start-up and shutdown are governed by an operation permit issued pursuant to the provisions of <u>Section 2, Regulation No. 2</u> 2.0 of 7 **DE Admin. Code** 1102.

# 2.0 Restrictions on Petroleum Refining Operations

2.1 In New Castle County, no person shall cause or allow the emission of carbon monoxide from any catalytic regeneration of a petroleum cracking system, petroleum fluid coker, or other petroleum process into the atmosphere, unless the carbon monoxide is burned at 1300°F for 0.3 seconds or greater in a direct-flame afterburner or boiler, or is controlled by an equivalent technique.
